NHBKA 2024 Membership Subscription Rates.

Four classes of membership are available

- **Registered**, a beekeeping member who has a number of colonies – see BDI notes below
- **Partner**, a member who is the partner of a Registered member – Annual Subscription £21.50
- **Country**, a member who does not keep bees – Annual Subscription £18.00
- **Junior**, a member who is under 18 years of age – Annual Subscription £17.50

Please note the following

- Registered members must have a minimum BDI insurance (i.e. £2.00 for up to 3 colonies)
- Partner members must be the partner of a Registered member
- Country & Partner members do not require BDI
- Normally Junior members do not require BDI
- Junior members who keep bees must have a minimum BDI insurance (i.e. £2.00 for up to 3 colonies) For further information please refer to the BBKA classes of membership at <https://www.bbka.org.uk/classes-and-benefits>

Bee Disease Insurance (BDI).

ALL COLONIES MUST BE INSURED.

Where, at the time of inspection by a duly authorised bee inspector, the number of colonies managed exceeds the number of colonies for which the premium has been paid, no cover will apply under this policy.

(When determining the number of colonies to insure, potential increase must be taken into consideration).
